A) PROJECT GROUP

Outdoor Meat Cookery- Project Group -- I recruited 4 members to serve on the Outdoor Meat Cookery team. I hosted 3 practices at my house one where we talked about what each member would cook and gave them basic info and then we practiced two times where we cooked.

Public Speaking Workshop – I conducted a public speaking workshop at our house. I scheduled and planned the workshop. I provided snacks and also secured a video camera to use to help with training and practice. We had 5 attend and we conducted the workshop 2 times.

Interview Workshop – I conducted a 4-H Sr. Interview workshop at our house for those going to Congress. We conducted the workshop 3 times and had 5 4-H members attend. I provided a video camera that we used for practice as well as snacks and refreshments.

C) JUDGING TEAM

Jr. High Meats Judging Coach – Recruited 4 members to serve on the Jr. High Meats team I held 3 practices where I developed three power points to use and secured everything needed for practice. We didn't win but everyone showed up for the contest so that was a positive

Western National Contest Meats – helped with fundraisers for the Denver trip, sold aprons, served at banquets, and secured donations. Assisted coach with practices and helped secure practice materials. I assisted other members with getting meat slides to put on Ipod.

Hosted 6 practices at our house and provided snacks and drinks during the workshops.

State Meats Judging Contest – Assisted coach with practices and continued to help secure practice materials, hosted practices at our house. We met 8 times after West National Contest to get prepared for State Contest in June. We have 4 members on the team plus a coach and a few parents who attend from time to time.

D) SPECIAL INTEREST

Portfolio Workshop – I helped conduct a portfolio workshop for Blount County 4-H. I helped get our 4-H specialist to come and present. I also took photos and helped with the set-up and take down. We had 15 4-H members and 5 adults in attendance. Conducted in Jan.

All Star High Council – As part of my responsibilities as an Eastern Region All Star officer I participated in our State All Star High Council meeting in January in Lebanon. I served on a the All Star Award planning committee and presented our proposals to the entire High Council. I also helped with the Regional Service Slide Show which was presented at the conference.

Spring All Star Conference – As part of my responsibilities as an Eastern Region All Star officer I helped (along with other members of council) plan and conduct our Spring All Star Conference as part of this conference I conducted a teamwork session which lasted an hour and was attended by 25 4-H All Stars. I also conducted a service project to benefit Ronald McDonald House and Second Harvest which had 15 4-H members participating. I planned and conducted the 50's sock hop which included the entire conference and consisted of games and trivia about the 50's. There were 95 All Stars and 10 adults at Conference this Spring.

Eastern Region All Star Leadership Retreat- Helped conduct our yearly leadership retreat for Our Eastern region All Star Council. We all had leadership roles during the event, I facilitated Part of our fall conference planning session and I chaired the service project committee. I also Got to cook some of the meals including my 'forte' grilling chicken on the first evening.

E) CAMP

Jr. High Camp – Was selected to serve as a Conference Asst. at Jr. High Camp this Summer. I helped teach a class on teamwork. and helped with the craft house. I was in charge of vespers one evening. I also worked as a teen leader for one of the groups. There were 200 4-H'ers at camp.

Jr. 4-H Camp – I served as a teen leader for Blount County at Jr. 4-H Camp. I was in charge of a group, of 8 girls in the cabin and I also helped with a project box session which had 25 4-H'ers. I also taught a class as part of June Dairy Month which all 300 4-H'ers at the camp attended. I Helped in the craft house and also was in charge of vespers on Tuesday night.
