1. **Leadership with 4-H groups.** Summarize this year's experiences as a junior or teen leader with one or more of the following kinds of 4-H groups: a) **project group**, b) **club**, c) **judging team**, d) **special interest group** and/or e) **camp**.

A) PROJECT GROUP

Clover Bowl Project Group - Serve as the coach of my younger sister's Clover Bowl Team. I conduct the practice sessions and organize the training as well as prepare materials such as the Clover Bowl Handbook, a large map of Tennessee as a visual aid, and I put together a power point to help team members better visualize some of the answers to the Clover Bowl questions. I also provide snacks and drinks for the members at each meeting. There are **4 members** on the team and we meet each Thursday night for 1 ½ hours. We have had 14 meetings to date in 2009.

Clover Bowl Project Group - I networked with another Clover Bowl coach to set up a practice with the team that I Coach in Blount County and the team that she coaches in Loudon County. I transported team members and once there Read questions to both teams and conducted mock games. We worked for 2 hours and there were **8 4-H members** And **4 adults** present.

B) CLUB

Blount County 4-H Honor Club - As the newly elected reporter of the Blount County Honor Club, I lead In several ways, I assist the president in regular meetings and help with initiation ceremonies that take place. I work on Committees for our service projects and fund raisers. We have **18 4-H members** who are active in our Honor Club.

D) SPECIAL INTEREST GROUP

Portfolio Workshop - Conducted a 4-H portfolio workshop at my house for **5 4-H members** and worked on their Portfolios. I contacted the members who came, set the date and made arrangements to get forms and other materials which were needed. **5 4-H members and three parents** attended. I spent a lot of time this year showing them how they could do their pictures using the computer. I also provided snacks and drinks.

Speaking Workshop - Conducted a 4-H speaking workshop for **4 4-H members** and **4 parents** and worked on prepared and Extemporaneous speaking to help 4-H'ers prepare for the Regional Contest.

E) CAMP

All Star High Council - As State All Star Chief I worked in cooperation with my fellow state offers to plan and conduct our State High council meeting. I worked with Mr. Justin Crowe, State All Star Advisor to make arrangements For the meeting. I also networked with my fellow officers to plan ice breakers, energizers, and team building workshops, and service projects. At the meeting I conducted a energizer and a team building exercise. I also presided over the conference including the business meetings. I also chaired the campfire committee which planned the All Star campfire to be held at Roundup this coming year at UT-Martin. There were **27 All Stars** and **11 adults** at the meeting.

All Star Planning - As Eastern Region All Star Chief I scheduled and planned and presided over an All Star planning meeting to determine initial plans for the Spring All Star Conference as well as to plan and to divide the responsibilities of the All Star council members as they conduct the Regional Public Speaking Opening and Awards Ceremonies and the jobs that each council member will do at the Eastern Regional Congress Readiness Day. There were **10 All Stars** and **4 Adults** attending this meeting. In addition to this meeting we met two other times including 1 Centra (Internet Conference) meeting to plan. Again **10 All Stars** and **4 adults** participated in each meeting

Spring All Star Conference - There were **125 All Stars** at Conference including **50 new Initiates** and **12 adults**. As All Star Chief I presided over the conference including the business meeting, initiation ceremony, officer elections And officer installation, as well as the opening assembly and the Senior Vespers ceremony. In addition I also designed the conference Tee-Shirt and made arrangements for printing...I also secured the DJ for the dance. At spring All Star Conference I taught 2 sessions on teamwork. About **45 All Stars** participated in these two workshops which were held at the recreation hall at camp. I also conducted an Honor Club workshop to help potential All Stars complete an Honor Club application there were **3 4-H'ers** in the workshop. I also worked with our volunteer leader advisor in conducting the new initiate orientation to prepare the 50 new initiates for the Initiation ceremony. I also helped conduct the small games activity on Friday night and I also led a group in one our service projects, making judging team plaques. I helped set up and decorate the campfire site for initiation Although this turned out to be in the recreation hall since it rained.
